

### **NOTICE TO CHERRY COUNTY RESIDENTS**

Beginning June 1, 2020, the Cherry County Treasurer's Office will be open to the public. However, it is still encouraged that you use the drop box located in the corridor of the new courthouse, use mail or online services especially if you are just renewing.

The Governor's original executive order is still in effect. All driver's licenses, state ID cards, vehicle, titling and registration expiration dates have been extended until 30 days after the order is lifted. Currently there is no set date for when this order may be lifted.

Should you choose to enter the building, we ask that you enter the Courthouse using the south doors going into the new courthouse and exit the door from the Assessor and Treasurer's office. We request that you sanitize your hands as you enter. Please observe any additional instructions posted for the different offices.

We are requesting the public to be conscientious of the social distancing guidelines. The Treasurer's office will only be able to accommodate 1 person at the counter at a time. Please have PATIENCE as we work through the backlog that the last two months have created. Please make sure you have all your paperwork before getting to the counter. (Title, Sheriff Inspection for outstate titles, Application for Title, Sales Tax Form or Bill of Sale, Proof of Insurance. If renewing registration renewal form that was mailed or old registration)

The Driver's License Examiner will be in Cherry County starting Tuesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> and will continue to be here every Tuesday and Wednesday. Only one person will be allowed in the office at a time. You will have to provide your own face masks as this is a requirement when seeing the DMV Examiner.
