The meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by Clerk Leonard. Roll call was taken. Present for the meeting were Cherry County Commissioners Mike McConaughey, Martin DeNaeyer, Nina Nelson, and Cherry County Clerk Samantha Leonard. The Open Meetings Act Poster was acknowledged by Clerk Leonard and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The board conducted their annual reorganization for 2025.

Nelson moved and DeNaeyer seconded to appointed Commissioner McConaughey as the Chairman of the Cherry County Board of Commissioners for 2025. Roll call vote: Aye – DeNaeyer, Nelson, McConaughey. The motion carried.

Nelson moved and McConaughey seconded to appointed Commissioner DeNaeyer as the Vice Chairman of the Cherry County Board of Commissioners for 2025. Roll call vote: Aye – Nelson, McConaughey, DeNaeyer. The motion carried.

The Board of Commissioners regular meeting minutes from December 31, 2024 were read. DeNaeyer moved and McConaughey seconded to approve the minutes with noted corrections. Roll call vote: Aye — McConaughey, DeNaeyer, Nelson. The motion carried.

The Board of Equalization meeting minutes from December 31, 2024 were read. Nelson moved and DeNaeyer seconded to approve the minutes as read. Roll call vote: Aye – DeNaeyer, Nelson, McConaughey. The motion carried.

Nelson moved and DeNaeyer seconded to designate Valentine Midland News and the Cherry County website (www.cherrycountyne.gov) as the official publications for Cherry County meeting notices and other required communications for 2025. Roll call vote: Aye – Nelson, McConaughey, DeNaeyer. The motion carried.

DeNaeyer moved and McConaughey seconded to appoint Samantha Leonard as the Cherry County Health Insurance Plan Administration for 2025. Roll call vote: Aye – McConaughey, DeNaeyer, Nelson. The motion carried.

DeNaeyer moved and McConaughey seconded to appoint Samantha Leonard as the Cherry County Sam.Gov Account Administrator for 2025. Roll call vote: Aye – DeNaeyer, Nelson, McConaughey. The motion carried.

Emergency Management Director Jessica Coyle updated the board re: LEOP plans, PET meetings, Keya Paha dispatching and additional costs associated with the recording system adding control stations and antennas to be able to listen to channels for Keya Paha.

The board reviewed the Treasurer's Semi-Annual Statement. McConaughey moved and DeNaeyer seconded to approve the Semi-Annual Statement. Roll call vote: Aye — DeNaeyer, Nelson, McConaughey. The motion carried.

At 10:57 a.m. the meeting was moved to the Sheriff's Conference Room upstairs.

At 11:03 a.m. the board met with Zelle Human Resources representative, Chad Thies, to discuss options of outsourcing Human Resources and assistance with payroll, job description updates, TimeClock Plus, policies/procedures, etc. This would provide an outlet for employees for Human Resource concerns. The board asked County Attorney Eric Scott to review a 6-month contract that was presented. No board action taken re: agenda item Zelle Human Resource Solutions.

McConaughey moved and Nelson seconded to omit the Cherry County Road Supervisor Job Description and position. Roll call vote: Aye – Nelson, McConaughey, DeNaeyer. The motion carried.

The Board discussed the Highway Superintendent Job Description drafted by County Attorney Eric Scott. Mr. Scott informed the board the function of the new job description is to re-establish chain of command with decisions stopping at the Board of Commissioners. Road Foremen report to the Commissioners and the Board has responsibility and authority. The Highway Superintendent would be an asset to the foremen on road building codes and following statute. JD asked that all foreman be involved in the 1- & 6-year plan for their specified district. Funds for payroll to be paid out of District 1 Road Fund, with a transfer out of District 2 and 3 for their portion of the payroll for the year to be done at the end of each fiscal year. Nelson approved and DeNaeyer seconded to approve the Cherry County Highway Superintendent Job Description with additions and corrections. Roll call vote: Aye – McConaughey, DeNaeyer, Nelson. The motion carried.

McConaughey moved and DeNaeyer seconded to appoint JD Osburn as the Cherry County Highway Superintendent. Roll call vote: Aye – DeNaeyer, Nelson, McConaughey. The motion carried.

The Board recessed from 12:45 p.m. to 1:01 p.m.

The Board recessed from regular session to convene as a Board of Equalization from 1:01 p.m. to 1:10 p.m.

The Board discussed a letter of support for the Cherry County GOP Resolution in opposition of the Animal ID mandate. Nelson moved and DeNaeyer seconded to approve and execute the letter of support for the Animal ID Resolution as prepared by County Attorney Eric Scott. Roll call vote: Aye — Nelson, McConaughey, DeNaeyer. The motion carried.

Lloyd Smith and the Board discussed the options of a contract with Mr. Smith to assist JD Osburn with the duties of the Highway Superintendent job, as needed. The Board asked Mr. Smith to present them with an hourly wage he would consider. No board action taken.

No board action taken on the agenda item re: Designate 2025 Budget Preparer.

The Board discussed approval or denial of the departments that do not currently have an elected official signing off on time sheets. The Board decided the following Supervisors will approve or deny time off for the below departments:
